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1. Eliminate Single-Use Water Bottles and Provide Water Refill Stations:



Please see attached examples of Safe Harbor Water Refill Stations at our properties. We also partnered with JUST water to provide our members with a boxed water alternative.

2. Eliminate Plastic Straws:



We provide all of our guests with paper straws -- especially in our restaurant, Belle's Cafe!

3. Serve Food with Plastic-Free Dinnerware:








All of our Race Weekend social events and restaurants follow the guidelines of plastic free.

We provided Sea Bags for all of our members (bags made out of used sails) & our Race Weekend sponsors provided reusable bags for guests - we promoted them on social media!

5. Award Practical Items or Use a Perpetual or Upcycled Trophy:








All of the awards from the weekend were practical items or upcycled trophies. We had silver goblets and sustainable cutting boards thanks to our friends at Soundview Millworks. The overall winner of Safe Harbor Race Weekend received a Beau Lake paddleboard.

6. Publicize Your Sustainability Efforts:



We publicized our sustainable efforts prior, during and after the event. (Main channels: e-blasts, social, website, digital signage and on property with the Clean Regatta activation locate in Race Village). Also promoted our sustainability efforts through our partnerships with brands like Beau Lake and X Shore. We also sent 33 e-blasts to 55,000+ members and included our sustainable partner on each e-blast.

7. Involve Local Organizations:







We partnered with Sailors of the Sea (RI), Soundview Millworks (RI) to provide sustainable awards, Seabags to provide reusable bags and gifts for our members! We also partnered with X Shore (electric boats) to get members on the water & Mark Set Bots to provide sustainable markers.

8. Post Educational and Reusable Signage:





We went as digital as we could with signage. All of Race Weekend's A-frames signs will be used again next year. We ordered Race Weekend flags that will also be used again next year and displayed a Sailors of the Sea flag that was showcased throughout the entire event. We also used TVs and ran logos (including SfS Clean Regattas) and messaging throughout all social events.

9. Serve Local Food or Source Seafood Sustainably:



We served local the entire weekend! We hosted a New England Clambake on Friday night and Saturday night we hosted a classic Rhode Island local food! At Belle's Cafe we always serve as local as we can.

10. Organize a Green Team:

11. Ensure Proper Waste Bin Placement and Signage:








We recycle at all of our properties as well as compost! These are out all year long for our members and showcased at Race Weekend. You can also see that we ensure proper bin placement.

12. Divert Food Waste from the Landfill:

13. Use Paperless Event Management:



We have a bunch of this! For sure went with the digital route. (e-blast, social, digital signage instead of sponsor banners, etc.) We communicated with e-blast for all of our logistics for the event, including QR codes for the agenda! We also used Yacht Scoring for all racing.

14. Host a Beach or Marina Clean-up:



In 2017, Safe Harbor was honored to partner with the Seabin Project as one of only 6 Global Pilot Partners in the world. At launch, we were proud to be the first organization in North America to install the innovative Seabin technology into our locations. At Safe Harbor New England Boatworks (a host location of Safe Harbor Race Weekend), we have installed a similar technology, the marina trash skimmer, which collects debris.

15. Promote Alternative Transportation:



We have bikes on property for alternative transportation. We also had one bus set up take all of our members our to Safe Harbor NEB from SH Newport (helped our carbon footprint)

16. Increase Awareness of Wildlife and Habitat Protection:

Through enterprise-wide initiatives like our Environmental Management System to partnering with solution-minded environmental organizations, we actively participate and invest in building a cleaner tomorrow for future generations.

18. Use Eco-Smart Race Management Techniques




We partnered with Mark Set Bots and rented them out for Race Weekend!
