Message First day Monday 11 May

Clean Regatta Monday Objective: Sustainable Energy & Power Management

- Prioritize Sailing: Maximize the use of sails and reduce engine dependence to eliminate fuel consumption and emissions.
- Use Renewable Energy: Install solar panels, wind generators, or water generators to meet energy needs sustainably.
- LED Lighting: Switch to LED lighting throughout the boat to reduce energy consumption.

Message Second day Tuesday 12 May

Clean Regatta Tuesday Objective: Waste Reduction & Pollution Control

- Eliminate Single-Use Plastics: Avoid plastic bottles, bags, and packaging. Opt for reusable alternatives.
- Responsible Waste Disposal: Sort waste and dispose of it at proper facilities ashore. Never dump trash overboard.
- Use Eco-Friendly Products: Choose biodegradable soaps, detergents, and sunscreens that do not release harmful chemicals or microplastics into the water.
- Engine Maintenance: Regularly maintain your engine to prevent oil or fuel leaks.

Message third day Wednesday 13 May

Clean Regatta Wednesday Objective: Marine Habitat Protection

- Anchor Safely: Avoid anchoring on sensitive areas like coral reefs or seagrass beds. Use designated, eco-friendly mooring buoys whenever possible.
- Respect Marine Life: Maintain a safe distance from marine life and avoid disturbing natural habitats.
- Sustainable Fishing: If fishing, adhere to local regulations and use sustainable practices.

Message fourth day Thursday 14 May

Clean Regatta Thursday Objective: Eco-Friendly Gear & Practices

- Sustainable Materials: Choose durable, eco-friendly boating equipment.
- Responsible Wastewater Disposal: Ensure all sewage and greywater is treated, for example, using a Marine Sanitation Device (MSD), or hold it to dispose of properly at a marina.
